**RESOLUTION NO. 4685, AS AMENDED**

**A RESOLUTION AWARDED A CONTRACT TO PRISM DESIGN &  
CONSTRUCTION, LLC FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS FUEL TANKS  
PROJECT RFP-15-27 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,348,090.00**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with FGC Chapter 54, Article IV, Competitive Bidding, Design-Build Proposals were solicited for the Public Works Fuel Tanks Phase I Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the successful responsive bidder for the project is Prism Design & Construction, LLC, of Wasilla, Alaska; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this project is provided through the Public Works Capital Account available in the amount of \$435,000, with award of the remaining balance of \$913,090.00 contingent upon Council approval of additional funding for the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Fairbanks,

SECTION 1. That the Bid by Prism Design & Construction, LLC, in the amount of One Million, Three Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand, Ninety Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,348,090.00) is hereby approved for award as follows: Of the total bid amount, \$435,000 is awarded upon the effective date of this Resolution; award of the remaining balance of \$913,090.00 is subject to Council approval of additional funding for the Public Works Fuel Tanks Project RFP-15-27.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract and such other documents in a form approved by the City Attorney as may be necessary to effect award of the contract.
